



Voluntary Prekindergarten Program

School Year 2016-17

Brevard Public Schools, in collaboration with the Early Learning Coalition of Brevard, offers a Voluntary Prekindergarten Program (VPK) at selected schools with limited enrollment. VPK is a FREE early learning program to prepare four-year-olds for kindergarten and build the foundation for school success. Students must be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2016 and reside in Florida to qualify for the program. Brevard Public Schools with VPK Programs are listed below.

Registration for VPK is a two-step process.

STEP 1 - Parents obtain a VPK Certificate of Eligibility.

In order to obtain a VPK Certificate of Eligibility, parents must visit the Early Learning Coalition website at www.elcbrevard.org to complete the on-line registration process. Please contact the Early Learning Coalition at (321) 637-1800 for additional information.

STEP 2 - Brevard Public Schools VPK registration will be held from April 11 – April 22, 2016 at the school sites listed below. Please note that registration does not guarantee a VPK slot. If there are more registrations submitted than space available at the school site on April 22, the VPK slots will be filled by a lottery or needs-based selection process. Registration will continue for programs with openings.

The items needed for registration at the school are the VPK Certificate of Eligibility, child’s original birth certificate, immunization record, current physical examination and two (2) forms of residence verification.
