





Summer Voluntary Prekindergarten Program

Brevard Public Schools, in collaboration with the Early Learning Coalition of Brevard, offers a Summer Voluntary Prekindergarten Program (VPK) at selected schools. VPK is a FREE early learning program to prepare four-year-olds for kindergarten and build the foundation for school success. Students must be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2016, reside in Florida, and did not attend the School Year VPK program to be eligible for Summer VPK.

STEP 1

In order to obtain a VPK Certificate of Eligibility, parents must visit the Early Learning Coalition website at www.elcbrevard.org to complete the on-line registration process. Please contact the Early Learning Coalition at (321) 637-1800 for additional information.

STEP 2

Parents may register at one of the summer VPK schools listed below beginning on May 1, 2017.

Parents *must* bring:

- VPK Certificate of Eligibility
- Child's original birth certificate
- Immunization record
- · Current physical examination
- Two (2) forms of residence verification

PLEASE NOTE:

- Summer VPK will be held <u>Monday Thursday only</u> from May 30 August 2, 2017. Schools will host a Meet & Greet on May 26 from 12:00-4:00. There will be no school on May 29 and July 4.
- > Student hours for the Summer VPK program will be 8:00-4:00.
- > School locations may change depending on student enrollment.
- > Services for students with an Individual Education Plan (IEP) will not be provided as a part of the Summer VPK program.
- > Parents must provide transportation.
- > Breakfast and lunch will be available.
